#### **QUICK SUMMARY OF EXPECTATIONS:**

- Load-in and set-up time begins at 6:00 am and must be completed by 6:45 am.
- All spaces are tented. There is no access to electricity.
- · Spaces are equivalent of a parking space.
- Vendor receives one 6' table and two chairs.
- Limited number of spaces available on a first-come basis.
- Maker/applicant must be present throughout the event.
- Application fee is non-refundable.
- Event happens rain or shine.

#### **Vendor Booths/Spaces Rules and Regulations**

- The fee is \$50 per 7.5' x 9' space. Vendors may secure a maximum of two spaces.
   <u>Fees must be paid in advance to confirm your spot.</u> You may drop off fees and fill out an application at The Whole Person, or pay on our website.

   <u>Fees are not refundable.</u> All spaces are sold on a first come/first serve basis.
- Vendors may reserve a space by calling Lea Klepees at 816-659-9403, or
  emailing your application to *lklepees@thewholeperson.org* and paying your
  fee online at *thewholeperson.org/jubilee*. Vendors will be assigned a space in
  advance in the order reservations are received.
- Vendors will be allowed to pull up next to our parking lot to unload/load,
   but will not be allowed onto the lot. We ask that all spaces be ready by 6:45 am.
   There will be a pancake breakfast going on from 9:00 am Noon.
- Vendors will be supplied a 6' table and 2 chairs. All spots are outdoors on our asphalt parking lot. Parking lot will be tented. There is NO ACCESS to electricity.
- No pets with the exception of ADA Service Animals.
- We ask that NO vendors leave before 1:00 pm.
- Vendors and their belongings must be off TWP property no later than 2:30 p.m.
